What to do

- 1. Place patient in Single Room
- 2. Ask patient to wear a mask
- 3. Practitioner droplet/contact precautions
 - Clean hands
 - Procedure mask with visor/eye protection, gown and gloves

What specimens to send

- 1. Specimen
 - NP Swab
 - Request



- 2. Virus Investigation coronavirus
 - Provide history/rational for swabbing on form

Aerosol Generating Medical Procedures (AGMP)

- 1. Airborne precautions
 - Fit tested N95 mask
 - AGMPs in Healthcare Settings
