- June 10: 9 south island cases, 4 central island cases, 0 north island cases
- June 9: 7 south island cases, 1 central island case, 5 north island cases

COVID-19 Vaccination:

- The latest provincial modelling released today shows BC is in a good position to continue to safely move forward with BC's Restart plan.
- Dr. Henry notes that close to 100 percent of the new cases being found in B.C. are now so-called "variants of concern."



- Most of these include the B.1.1.7 and the P.1 variant, although a small number of the newer B.1.617.2 variants have also been found.
- For the first time in weeks, all regions in BC now have a viral reproductive rate below one meaning less than one new transmission per positive case.
 - The provincial average is between 0.57 and 0.63.
- The B.C. Centre for Disease Control <u>released figures</u> showing a single dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine reduced the risk of older adults catching COVID-19 by 66 per cent, and worked against the Alpha and Gamma variants.
- The Government of Canada announced that fully vaccinated Canadians and permanent residents crossing the border into Canada will soon no longer be required to stay at a hotel for part of their quarantine period.
