COVID-19 Vaccine Information:

- Provincewide Booster Dose is next step in COVID-19 Immunization Plan
 Provincial Health Officer Dr. Bonnie Henry announced British Columbia's COVID-19
 booster dose immunization plan yesterday for targeted groups and the general
 population.
 - Vaccine booster dose rollout will be in a similar priority order as first and second doses of COVID-19 vaccine were delivered.
 - During the final months of 2021, invitations to book booster doses will be sent to health-care workers who were immunized early and with shorter intervals between doses (e.g. ICUs, EDs and COVID units) as well as people over age 70, and Indigenous people aged 12 and up.



- Starting in January, people in BC who had their second dose at least 6 months ago will get an invitation to book a booster dose.

 COVID-19 Vaccination Status Information and Preventive Measures
 The main update clarifies information for staff who received their first dose before
 October 12 (hospital and community) but have not received their second dose. This
 PHO order explains that all employees in the health sector will be required to be fully
 (two doses) vaccinated against COVID-19 by October 26, 2021.
- Order of the Provincial Health Officer: Updated Residential Care COVID-19
 Preventive Measures
 - The main update clarifies information for staff who received their first dose before September 22, but have not received their second dose.
- Immunization Manual: Additional COVID-19 Vaccine Resources

 The BC Communicable Disease Control Manual, Chapter 2: Immunization (BC Immunization Manual) provides best practice guidelines to direct the provision of immunization services.

COVID-19 Updates:

- Baricitinib oral tablets for COVID-19: Use and Access
 - The supply of tocilizumab injection and sarilumab injection is unstable due to increased global demand. If tocilizumab or sarilumab are not available for the treatment of severe COVID-19, baricitinib oral is recommended as an alternative.
- Updated Poster: Guidelines for Visitors to LTC and Seniors' AL Facilities
 This updated poster focuses on the most current visitor guidelines put in place at Long-Term Care and Assisted Living facilities, when it comes to COVID-19 vaccination. All visitors must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 to enter the facility. Excluding children under 12 years, those with an approved medical exemption or for an end-of-life visit.
- Province intends to introduce legislation to extend key COVID-19 orders
 Due to the ongoing fourth wave of the pandemic, the Province intends to introduce amendments to the COVID-19 Related Measures Act to extend it beyond the repeal date of Dec. 31, 2021.

 Updates include information regarding indoor events (Section C), proof of vaccination (Section D) in regards to participants of events and gatherings needing proof of full vaccination and much more.


• Electronic Clinical Documentation Go-Live Update
