



• <u>Expression of Interest for Delivering COVID-19 Vaccines</u>

Are you a midwife, nurse practitioner or physician able to join Island Health's time-limited COVID-19 immunization team? With the rapid spread of the Omicron variant, Island Health is ramping up immunization capacity across the island and needs your help to fill immunizer shifts. • <u>Working after a COV ID-19 test or exposure</u>

The isolation period following a COVID-19 test or exposure has been reduced to 5 days in certain situations. If you have symptoms of COVID-19 you can call the healthcare expedited testing line at 1-833-737-9377 to access testing. Note that this phone number is **not** for family members or members of the public.

COVID-19 Updates:

Appropriate Use of PPE: N95 in elevated risk scenarios only

All care providers are asked to follow the <u>BCCDC Point of Care Risk Assessment</u> process for all patient/client/resident interactions. If the assessment identifies an 'elevated risk', additional PPE such as respirators will be provided to the healthcare worker. An updated BCCDC/MoH/ Island Health document outlines the <u>most appropriate PPE</u> for healthcare workers by clinical activity and setting.

• <u>Self-reporting COV ID-19 Positive Test Result: BCCDC Portal</u> It is important for medical staff and all people in BC to self-report a positive COVID-19 test result. Confidential self-reporting through the BCCDC portal provides contact tracers with important information to help determine those in the population who may need additional supports during the course of their infection.

COVID-19 Outbreaks:

• <u>Island Health declares COVID-19 outbreaks at five long-term care homes</u> Outbreaks have been declared at Aberdeen Hospital, Glenwarren Lodge and Selkirk Seniors' Village in Victoria and at Kiwanis Village Lodge and Eden Gardens in Nanaimo.

 <u>Island Health declares COVID-19 outbreak at Amica Douglas House long-term</u> <u>care home in Victoria</u>
 Island Health declared a COVID-19 outbreak on the second floor at Amica
 Douglas House long-term care home in Victoria. Two staff members at the site have tested positive for COVID-19. At this time, no residents are experiencing

symptoms and the outbreak declaration is limited to the second floor.

• Physicians practicing in Rural Communities

If you are a physician practicing in a <u>rural community</u> you may qualify for rural incentives. The Rural Physician Confirmation Process is an annual process to determine physician eligibility for rural benefits, such as the Rural Continuing Medical Education (RCME) and the Rural Retention Program (RRP). In order to

determine eligibility for rural benefits, the Ministry of Health needs our full count of physicians residing and/or practicing in rural communities by mid-January 2022.
