- Pandemic Planning COVID-19 Update | Feb 23
 - RAPID TESTS: Health Minister Adrian Dix provided details about BC's <u>expanded strategy</u> to distribute rapid test kits. People over the age of 70 will be able to pickup a free five-test kit at pharmacies as early as this Friday.
 - NEW VACCINE: A new vaccine, Novavax, has been approved by Health Canada and is expected to arrive in BC in the next week to 10 days.

- PHO Order on Workplace Safety updated
 - The Provincial Health Officer (PHO) has updated the PHO Order on Workplace Safety, to support the transition of employees back into the workplace.
- <u>Updated: Personal Protective Equipment FAOs</u>
 - Two Island Health PPE FAQs documents have been updated 1. Eye Protection FAQs (# 1, 2 and 5). 2. Mask Policy FAQs (#16 masking guidance for patients on Droplet and Contact Precautions) has been added.
