Hospitalization in our region has started to increase from the lowest level in late March. We reached our lowest level of hospitalizations on March 22, with 27, and since then the number of COVID cases in hospital has climbed to 73. COVID therapeutics updates including Paxloid now being prescribed through community providers and Remdesivir is being provided by IV.

The BCCDC Communicable Disease Manual was updated to indicate that clients requesting a shorter interval between doses should be informed that this is not optimal for protection, but their request for an earlier dose should be granted, without need for MHO approval.

In April of 2016, the province declared a public health emergency in response to significant increases in opioid-related deaths. In 2016, 993 people died in BC because of poisoned drugs. In 2021, this number increased to 2,232.

Community Virtual Care is a merger of Home Health Monitoring (chronic disease management) and Intensive Home Monitoring (COVID and heat exhaustion monitoring) which enhances, expands, and regionalizes community virtual care. The team can now support more clients after-hours and on weekends, providing service from 8a-8p, seven days a week. Community Virtual Care is a *free*, innovative program that uses remote patient monitoring, virtual visits and the telephone to support clients living with chronic disease (Chronic Kidney Disease, COPD, Diabetes, Heart Failure, Hypertension) from the comfort of their home.
