 and emerging evidence to allow for the real-time application of the surgical

BCCDC Guidance Manual updated for COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility: Appendix A was revised per the updated list of moderately to severely immunocompromised criteria on the government of B.C. webpage. The criteria previously indicated dates and has been revised to indicate time intervals.

 This updated BCCDC guidance document addresses key therapeutic areas of concern for clinicians with recommendations sorted by severity of patient illness.

 BCCDC guidance documents on tixagevimab/cilgavimab (EvusheldTM), a longacting monoclonal antibody, for prevention of COVID-19 in individuals who are

 COVID-19 vaccine.
