The work towards recovery in our personal and professional lives and in the health care system continues as Island Health prepares for another respiratory season. Island Health anticipates that influenza will return in force after two seasons of low influenza activity.

• Fall Respiratory Season | Provincial Update

• Approval of more Bivalent vaccines

Adrian Dix, Minister of Health, and Dr. Bonnie Henry, B.C.'s provincial health officer, have released the following joint statement on the approval of the Pfizer-BioNTech bivalent COVID-19 vaccine.

• <u>Discontinuing Additional Precautions Related to COVID-19</u>

This BCCDC guidance document updated the duration of additional precautions for patients with COVID-19 exposure from 14 day to 10 days.

• Primary Care Providers Influenza Vaccination - MHOletter

MHO letter providing information for primary care providers on health authority clinics providing both COVID-19 and influenza vaccination. Primary Care

Providers can start placing influenza vaccine orders the week of October 24th with expected distribution the week of October 31st.

 Provincial COVID-19 testing guidance has been updated. PCR testing is no longer recommended for symptomatic health care workers, first responders, staff and residents in congregate settings unless they meet other criteria for testing.
- <u>BC Coroners Service report shows toxic drug supply has claimed 1,468 in the firth 8 months of 2022</u>

Preliminary reporting released by the BC Coroners Service shows that the toxic drug supply claimed the lives of at least 169 British Columbians in August 2022, bringing the total number of lives lost in the calendar year to 1,468.

• <u>Illicit Drug Toxicity Island Health Update</u>

Deaths caused by illicit toxic drugs continue to increase across the province and in the Island Health region. Dr. Réka Gustafson provides data on the illicit drug toxicity within the Island Health region.

• Relationship Declarations in the EHR - It is your responsibility

When opening an electronic health record (EHR) you are accessing confidential patient information. It is mandatory that you establish the relationship (reason for accessing) you have to the patient record. It is essential to select the correct relationship. What you declare informs the permanent legal record, which is audited and accessible by the patient.
