• Ebola Preparedness

On September 20, 2022, an Ebola outbreak was declared in Uganda. The risk for

Ebola Virus Disease in BC and within Island Health is very low. As a precaution, the province has asked all BC health authorities to ensure we are prepared should we be presented with a Person Under Investigation (PUI) for Ebola infection.



- Winter is coming! (Actually, it's influenza season)
 - Dr. Mike Benusic, Medical Health Officer, expects a rise in influenza cases in November and encourages people to book appointments to receive the influenza vaccine in the coming weeks.
- Clinical Practice Guide for the Use of Therapeutics in Mild-Moderate COVID-19
 The BC COVID Therapeutics Committee has updated their therapeutics guide.
- Update to COVID-19 testing guidance and PCR tests for health care workers
 The BCCDC COVID-19 testing guidance document has been updated: PCR testing is no longer recommended for all symptomatic health-care workers, first

responders and staff and residents in congregate settings unless they meet other criteria for testing. Testing continues to be recommended for people when a positive or negative result will help inform their care and treatment.
