Last Call for rural physicians to complete the Annual Rural Physician Confirmation Survey

Physicians practicing within a designated Rural Practice Subsidiary Agreement Community in Island Health, are asked to complete this survey by January 16, 2023, to ensure that there is no disruption to their rural benefits. The information collected in the Annual Rural Physician Confirmation survey determined eligibility for all Rural Programs.



Updated Medical Staff Rules and The Proposed Changes January 2023

The Medical Staff Legislative Committee is undertaking a review of the Medical Staff Rules (MSR). The last update to the MSR was in 2020. The proposed updates include the incorporation of language addressing Cultural Safety, Diversity, Equity and Inclusion principles and changes to MOST orders for non-privileged physicians.
