PRIME: Midwives and Nurse Practitioner enrollment deadline is <u>April 23rd</u>

PRIME is a largely automated application for health professionals to request permission to access PharmaNet for both sites and individuals.

 Registrants of the College of Physicians and Surgeons of BC with existing PharmaNet access who want to retain it must enrol in PRIME by August 15, 2023.
