


Thank You, Dr. Ian Thompson – A Message from Dr. Ben Williams, VP Medicine, Quality and Research, and Chief Medical Officer

RURAL PHYSICIAN COUNT

If you are a physician practicing in a rural community, you are required to complete the annual Rural Physician Count survey to determine eligibility for rural incentives. You should have received an email on Tuesday December 5 requesting to complete this survey, however, if you did not receive this notification please access the survey form

The information gathered is used to determine isolation points and eligibility for all rural individual payments and community funding (<u>Rural Practice Programs - Province of British Columbia (gov.bc.ca</u>).
