


# 5 RJH Key Messages Issue: June 16, 2024

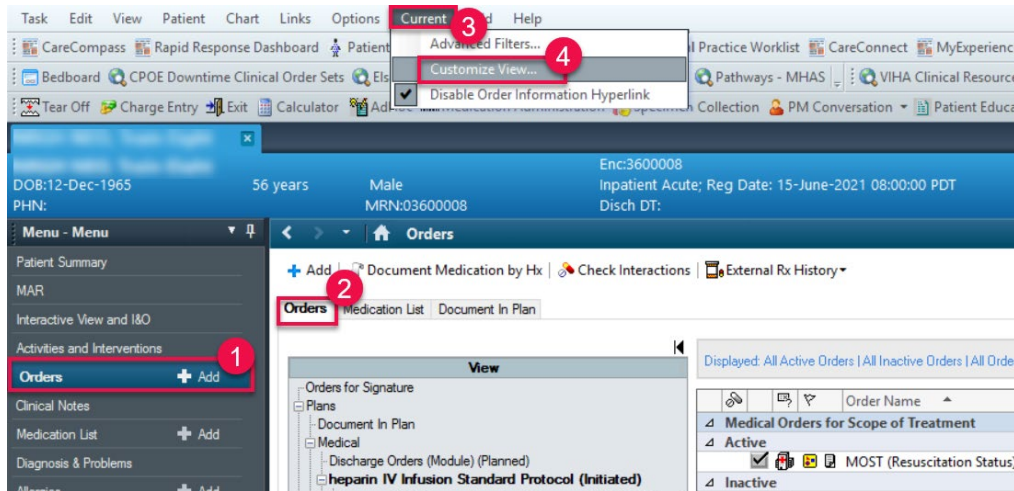
## PRACTICE REMINDERS

<p><b>Documenting a Specimen Collection</b></p>	<p><b>What you need to know:</b> In order for lab to know you have collected your specimen you need to scan the patient’s wrist band and then scan the specimen.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Select <b>Specimen Collection</b> from the toolbar.</li> <li>The <b>Collection Details</b> window displays.</li> <li>Scan the patient’s wrist band per PPID</li> <li>Scan the label on the specimen, look for the check marks, and sign.</li> </ul> 
<p><b>Charge Barcode Scanners</b></p>	<p><b>*Reminder-</b> to ensure you dock your barcode scanners between use and check the cradle and the dock for good connectivity between shifts. This will ensure they are changed and ready for use.</p>
<p><b>Questions about Medication Orders</b></p>	<p><b>*Reminder</b> -If you have questions about patient orders connect with the Most Responsible Physician for clarity.</p>

**Customizing the Orders and Medications List Tabs**

**What you need to know:** You can customize the Orders and Medication List Tabs to provide a preferred view.

- Select **Orders** from the menu.
- Select the **Orders** tab.
- Click **Current** from the upper menu bar.
- Select **Customize View...**



- The **Customize View** window opens.

Verify **\*Selected Columns** are listed and appear in the following order:

- Interactions
- Quick Discontinue
- Type
- Notifications
- Order Name
- Details
- Last Updated
- Status
- Start
- Stop
- Ordering Physician

Click the **Add** or **Remove** buttons to adjust the **\*Selected columns** list.

Click the up or down arrow buttons to re-order the **\*Selected columns** list.

Verify the following for **Select how you want to group & sort orders**:

**Group Orders by:** Clinical Category

- **Then by:** Active/Inactive
- **Sort Orders by:** Order Name
- The Ascending option is selected

Click OK.

\*To keep your changes, ensure you have only one chart tab open and use the **Exit** on the toolbar to close Powerchart.



- Exiting in this way ensures your customizations will remain when you re-open Powerchart



**Orders Starting Today or Tomorrow: One Time**

What You Want	Collection Priority	What to do with the Collection Date/Time?
I need it <b>right NOW</b>	STAT	Do not change default.
I need it soon	As Soon As Possible	Do not change default.
I want it tomorrow morning	AM Early Run	Do not change default. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ordering cutoff for AM Early Run is 0445.</li> <li>• Orders placed between 0445-0800 will have a pop-up to advise that orders for TODAY should be placed as Routine or STAT instead.</li> </ul>
I want it for the next collection round	Routine	Do not change default. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lab collects hourly until 2300. Ordering cutoff is 15 minutes before the hour.</li> </ul>
I need it at 14:00	Timed Study	<b>Enter</b> collection date of today 'T' and time of 14:00.
I want to request an add on	Routine Add On or Stat Add On	Do not change default. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>TIP:</b> No longer necessary to call lab.</li> </ul>

## CPOE TIPS & TRICKS

<p><b>Albumin Ordering</b></p>	<p><b>What you need to know:</b> When ordering Albumin, you will need to add the mL per dose and the total number of doses.</p> 
<p><b>Related Results in Medication Profile Mpage</b></p>	<p><b>What you need to know:</b> You can view labs while ordering medication by selecting the Related Results. This can be found in the view pane.</p> 
<p><b>Range Dose High Limit Same as Dose</b></p>	<p><b>What you need to know:</b> When ordering a <b>RANGE DOSE</b> medication, the Dose and High Limit (mg) should be the same.</p>



morphine (morphine ... Order 16-Jun-2024 00:05 ... RANGE DOSE 2 mg to 5 mg, Soln-Inj, IV, Q5MIN, PRN for pain, Start Date 16-Jun-2024 00:05 PDT, Give as bolus



### Medications with Multiple Routes

What you need to know: When ordering a medication with multiple routes of administration the drug form must be the same. When its not the same you will need to place multiple orders.
