Purpose:	To describe the privileging process for surgical centre that are deemed to have an association with another larger site.				
Rules and	This process is consistent with the Medical Staff Bylaws and Rules, specifically: • Medical Staff Bylaws: Articles 3 & 4

Outcomes:	 Target providers who hold privileges at a major surgical site will be automatically granted privileges at any associated surgical sites. There will be a streamlined approach to privileging applications. Greater workforce flexibility and mobility between sites. 				

1.0 Association to Major Sites

In Island Health, smaller surgical centres may have an association with a larger site. Presently, these associations are defined as follows:

2.0 Target Providers

For the purposes of this guideline, target providers are: Anesthesiologists; Surgeons; and Surgical Assists.

3.0 Surgical Site Privileging

- Target providers who are granted privileges at a major site will also be granted privileges at the corresponding associated site(s) as defined in the table above
- Target providers only holding privileges at an associated site, however, must submit an application for privileges at major sites.
