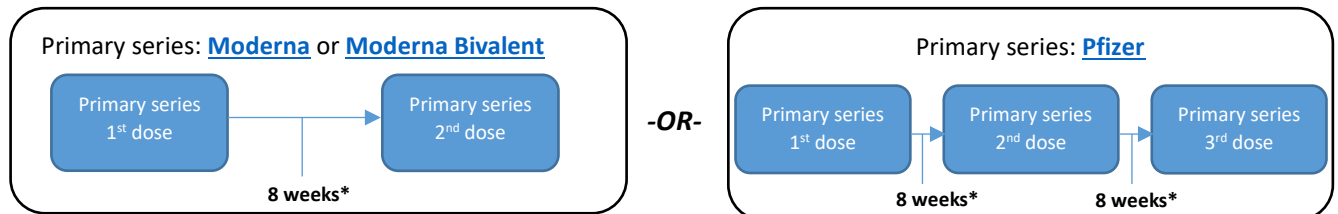


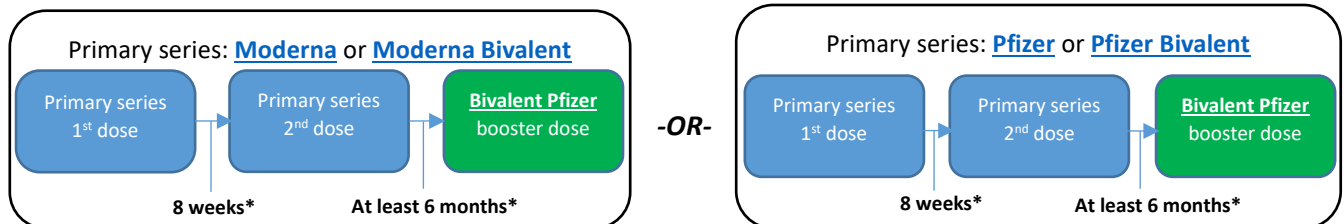

People who are **NOT** Moderately or Severely Immunocompromised

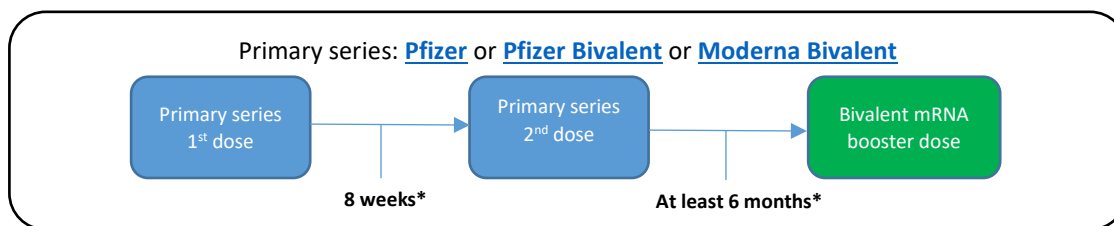
People ages 6 months to 4 years (inclusive)



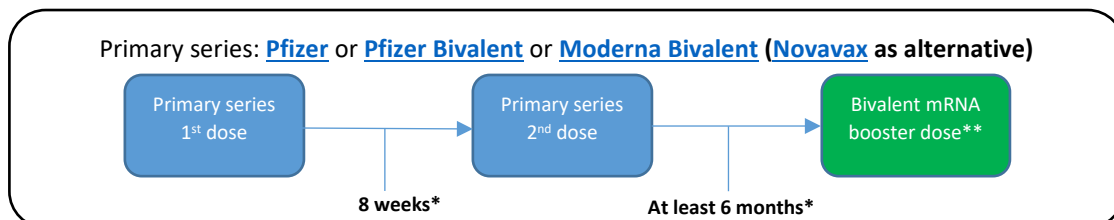
People age 5 years



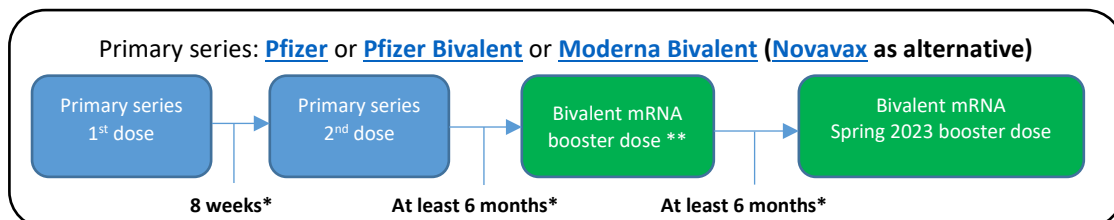
People ages 6-11 years (inclusive)

People ages 18 years and older at high risk of severe illness from COVID-19 ***



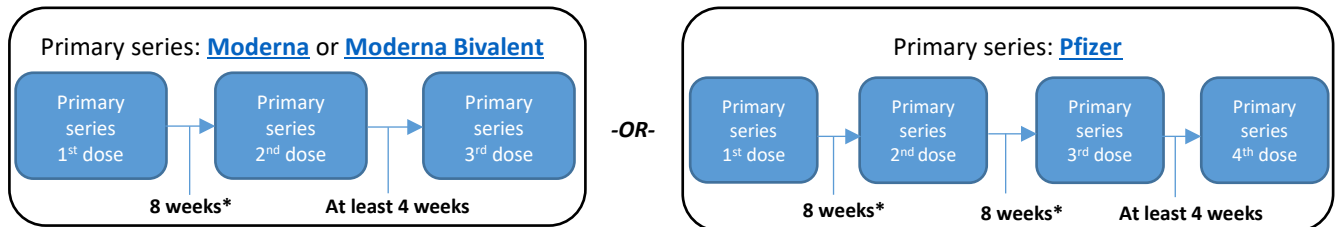

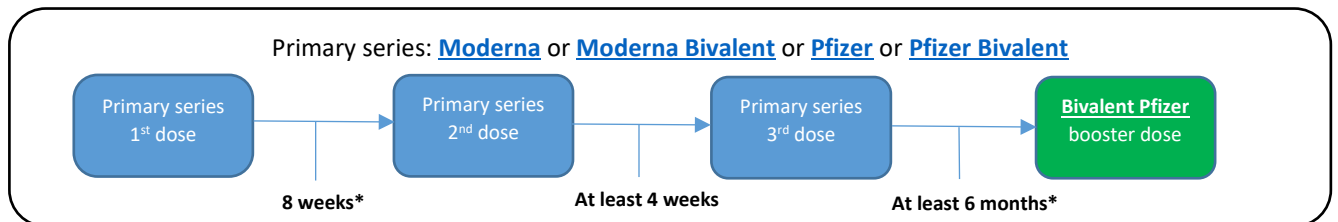

People who *ARE* Moderately or Severely Immunocompromised

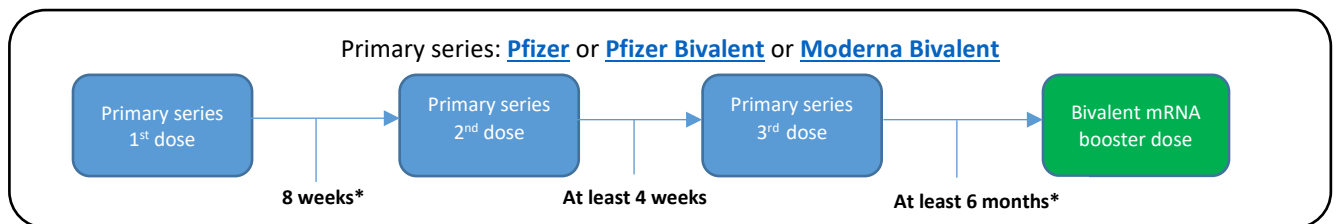
People ages 6 months to 4 years (inclusive)



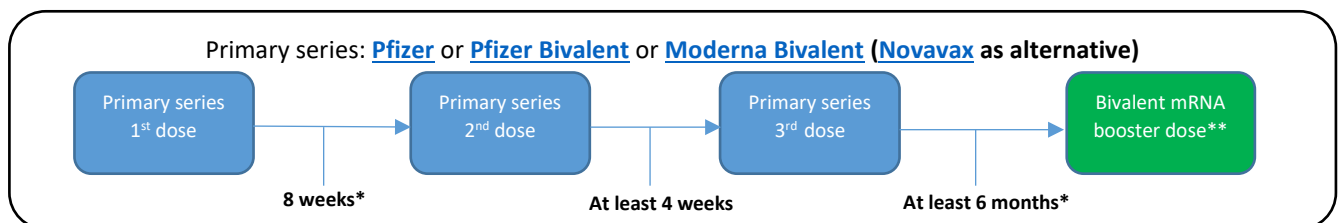
People age 5 years



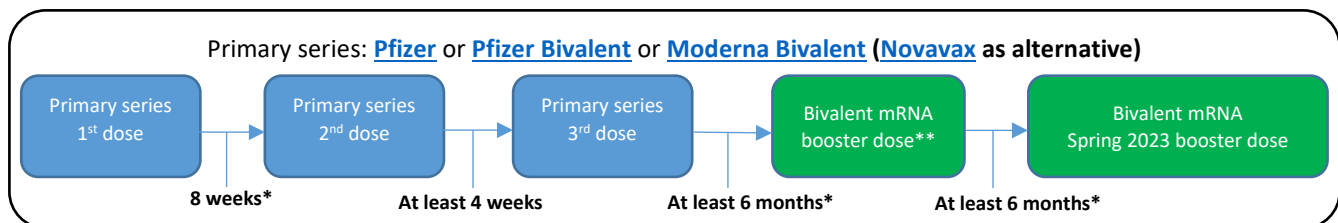
People ages 6-11 years (inclusive)
