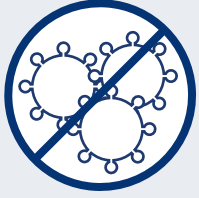




Coronavirus COVID-19

Visitor Restrictions Are in Effect



All visitors will be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and other respiratory illness prior to every visit



All visitors must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19 to enter the facility*



All visitors must provide acceptable proof of COVID-19 vaccination



Clean hands using soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer before and after visiting



Cough or sneeze into your elbow and do not touch your face



Respect personal space



Up to two visitors are allowed at a time**

*Does not apply to children who are ineligible for the vaccine, those with an approved medical exemption, visitation for end-of-life care and in other specific care settings such as emergency rooms, intensive care units, pediatric care, labour and delivery.

**Emergency rooms and intensive care units are limited to one support person at a time. More than two visitors may be allowed for pediatric care, labour and delivery, palliative and end-of-life care.
