Bill C-7




- 18 years of age, CDN, eligible for health services in Canada
- Serious, irreversible decline and incurable medical condition which causes suffering
- Voluntary request where one has capability of making healthcare decision specific for MAiD
- Aware and informed of all means to treat the condition that is causing suffering
- Death must be reasonably foreseeable
- 10 day 'period of reflection'
- Waiver of final consent, if death is reasonably foreseeable

Waiver of Final Consent

Audrey's amendment

- Allows for an alternate provider
- Completion of the waiver requires that the patient has been assessed and meets all the requirements for 'RF' MAID and has planned that MAID
- Can be completed at any time while the patient has capacity
- Can be completed for multiple named providers
- Can not be completed for a 'team'.



Safeguards within C-7

- Must be without coercion, have capacity.
- Can withdraw their request at any time, even just pefore provision.
- Must be made in writing
- ONE witness. This witness can be a PAID health care professional providing direct care and support to the patient.
 <u>Request for MAiD Form 1632</u>

Instructions for completion of Request for MAiD

• If death is not reasonably foreseeable, must have 2 independent assessments by physician or Nurse Practitioner, <u>and/including</u> consult with an expert in the field of the disease/disability/condition which is causing the patient suffering.



Unregulated professionals /

Practice may be limited by

Facilities with certain Religious affiliations

Death is <u>NOT</u> Reasonably Foreseeable



- Consultation with an 'expert' if neither assessor professes 'expertise'.
- 90-day assessment period (from start of first assessment Day 0).
- Waiver of final consent is **NOT** available.




What is on the horizon...



- Joint committee of the Senate and House for a 'comprehensive review' within one year.
- Mental Health as sole underlying reason for requesting MAiD permissible in 2023 (expert and independent review).
- Collection of race-based data identification of gaps in health care for marginalized groups.




Effect of C7 on the MAID office


