Re: Regional release of new Delirium order set for non-activated sites

**Background:** The Delirium (Module) Order Set is an integral part of the <u>Delirium Care pathway</u>, as it provides current standardized orders that align with the steps on the care pathway.

Following a successful pilot at Victoria General Hospital as part of the Delirium Care Initiative, the new 'Delirium (Module)' order set is now available as a paper order set for all applicable sites.

## What do I need to know?

- The New Delirium order set, titled 'Delirium (Module)', is now available:
  - **For non-CPOE activated sites:** Via the <u>Island Health Order Sets library</u> (in the <u>Geriatrics</u> folder and <u>Medicine</u> folders).
  - For CPOE-activated sites (e.g. RJH, VGH, NRGH, GRH): Delirium (Module) is available in Cerner PowerChart.
- Delirium (Module) is appropriate for both Adult and Geriatric patient populations.
- The previous delirium order set 'Management of Delirium in Older Adults', has been archived and should no longer be used.
- Providers at all applicable non-CPOE activated sites are asked to transition to the new Delirium (Module) order set for patients diagnosed with delirium.

## What do I need to do?

- Please remove outdated paper order sets for delirium from your unit.
- Consider printing the new order set in small batches, from the OS Library or Print Services.
- Please share this notification with relevant colleagues and staff at your site.
