What we have done:

The Medical Health Officers in collaboration with the Regional Manager of Communicable Disease and Clinical Pharmacy have requested minor updates to this order set to improve communication surrounding Rabies Immune Globulin and Rabies Vaccine administration. The following updates have been completed:

- Created a Medical Health Officer Communication Order that includes a mandatory field to enter in name of MHO contacted
- Added the names of two new Medical Health Officers
- Added checkbox (selected) to “Obtain consent for Blood Product Administration”
- Added Documentation Communication order to remind nursing to complete and fax the RPEP Administration Form
- Included narratives in the Immune Globuline section and the Vaccine section with additional details surrounding their administration
