STRUC COURSE DESCRIPTION

A one day simulation based course involving the team based resuscitation of critically injured trauma patients. There will be 3 high fidelity simulation scenarios, plus an airway station including surgical airway practice.

Crisis resource management (CRM) principles of leadership, closed loop communication, teamwork, resource utilization, situational awareness, and problem solving will be emphasized during the debriefing sessions. Resuscitation management priorities and strategies in various clinical scenarios will be highlighted, as well as review of latest evidence and clinical practice guidelines during small group discussions.

A knowledge of ATLS based principles for physicians is important, and this course will build on the basics of ATLS.

This course is fully accredited for physicians through both colleges for emergency medicine.

There is a limit of 16 physicians with 4 groups rotating through 4 stations. Emergency department RN's and RT's involved in trauma resuscitation will be included in the small groups to create familiar teams that work together.
