Providers will gain the knowledge and skills to improve the care of trans patients, including how to: • Effectively utilize common terminology when discussing gender and gender-related care • Identify common health disparities and implications for care • Take an effective patient history using appropriate language Utilize clinical practice resources and connect patients to gender-affirming resources and support Register HERE. Step 3: **UBC CPD Advanced Gender-Affirming Primary Care** 3.0 Mainpro+ learning credits This 3-hour, live medical education training (offered in two 90 minute webinars) builds upon the skills taught in Step 2 and covers more advanced topics.
