CONSIDERING SUBMITTING YOUR QI WORK FOR PUBLICATION

Connect with one of our Mentors.

- Our mentors are PQI alumni who have published their work and want to help you get into the publishing world. The mentors can help develop your knowledge of writing a publication, guide you through the submission process, and direct you to the right channels to get your project published.

WORKING ON YOUR MANUSCRIPT

Attend one of our QI Writing Workshops.

- Hosted by previous PQI graduates who have experience with publishing, these workshops explain ways to get your work showcased, provide an overview of SQUIRE guidelines, and detail important things to know during the publication process. Participants will have opportunities to work on their manuscript during the workshop and receive feedback.
- Workshop pre-requisites: Participants have conducted PDSA cycles and collected data for their project. They also have started on a manuscript that would be ready for journal peer review within a few weeks after attending the workshop.
- Space is limited! If you are unable to attend a workshop, you will be added to a waitlist.

FINDING SOMEONE TO REVIEW YOUR MANUSCRIPT

Access our Peer Editing services.

- Peer editing is available upon request from our mentors.

READY TO SUBMIT YOUR MANUSCRIPT

Apply to us to Cover Your Journal Submission Fees.

- You may be able to get your journal submission fee paid for, if you meet the following eligibility criteria:
 - > I have completed PQI cohort training (Level 3).
 - > I have received an introduction to QI manuscript writing (ie. SQUIRE or other).
 - > I have a physician on my team.
 - > My manuscript has been proofread by a writing mentor.

Receive Sessional Funding for your time and hard work.

- Physicians who have completed and submitted through our application process may also receive up to 7 hours of sessional funding.
- There is limited space available per year to support publications, so sessional funding is not guaranteed for all applicants.

Share your project.

- Join our provincial mailing list, to remain updated about upcoming events and conferences where you may be able to showcase your PQI project, as well as remain up to date with other PQI news.
