Introducing the Island Health PROVIDER PROFILE



What is the Provider Profile?

The Provider Profile is an interactive web-based tool for physicians and midwives who provide care at Island Health.



Using Provider Profile, physicians and midwives who hold Most Responsible Provider (MRP) status for admitted patients can access data about their patient population and core measures. Providers can also see aggregate data for their service for a 5-year window. The term 'provider' is used at Island Health to describe medical staff who can order tests and prescribe medications.

What data is available?

Individual providers can see data related to:



- Patient population summarizing key characteristics such as age, gender & comorbidities.
- Core measures related to the dimensions of quality and align with Health Authority organizational performance measures.
- Department-specific measures for delivery providers.

Department-specific measures for pediatrics and emergency medicine are in development.

What should I use it for?

The Provider Profile supports providers in team-based quality improvement (QI) & individual continuous professional development (CPD).

Data is refreshed annually, allowing individual providers to see how their change ideas and actions impact their data, and teams can reflect on how QI impacts the group mean.

Who has access?

The Provider Profile is for individual provider level results - only you can see your own data.



Monitoring, performance measurement, & quality assurance are out of scope.

Patients do not have access to the Provider Profile - patients can sign up to view their Island Health personal health information using the MyHealth patient portal.

How is data attributed?

Attribution refers to the process of linking providers and patient data by assigning a specific provider to a patient's record.



For the Core Measures & Patient Population we used MRP to link providers to their data. MRP is generally responsible for the greatest portion of a patient's length of stay.

For Delivery Measures, data is also available for Intervention Providers. Intervention Providers are documented as present at the in-hospital intervention for maternity care, they are linked to patients through deliveries.
